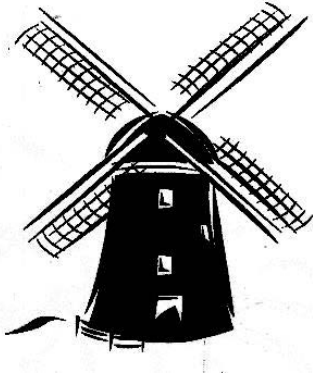


Lunch was good too- a fantastic atmosphere!

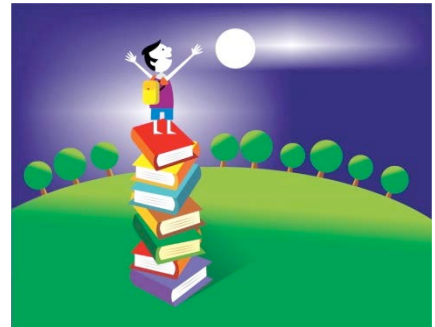

PARKING

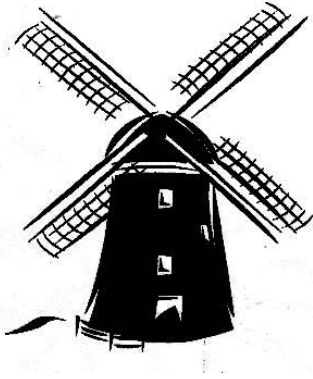

Textiles = 245kg

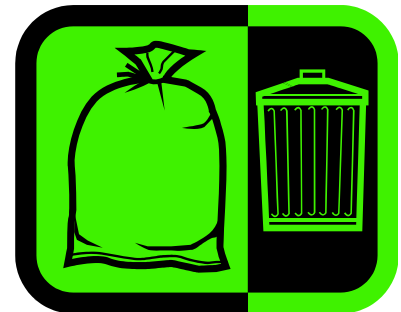
As a result, 9,800 Science into Schools Points have been credited to your online account."

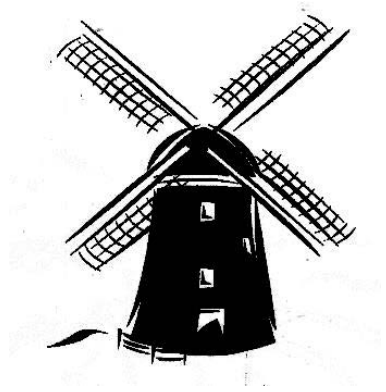
