We are aware that these are the latest craze but they are not allowed in school.

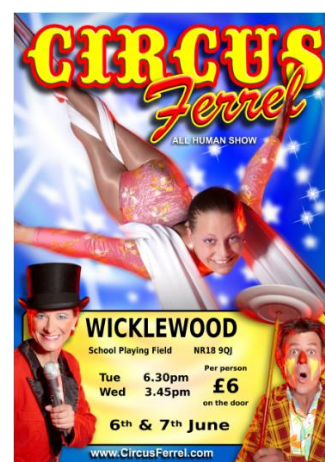
