We spent lots of time learning about the zones of regulation during our first week back at

## Geography

## Maths

We have enjoyed starting our new topic, fractions, we recapped what fractions were by getting outside into the forest school area. We made parts of a whole using sticks. This was a great starting point for a rich discussion. We thought about the fact that each part must be an equal size, reminders about what numerator and denominators are, unit and non-unit fractions and equivalent fractions (some people noticed that 2 putting their parts together would make the same amount as another fraction e.g. 2/6 = 1/3).
