We have continued our learning from home school about place value within 50 in maths and learning our set 3 sounds in phonics, practising our spellings and sentence writing skills.

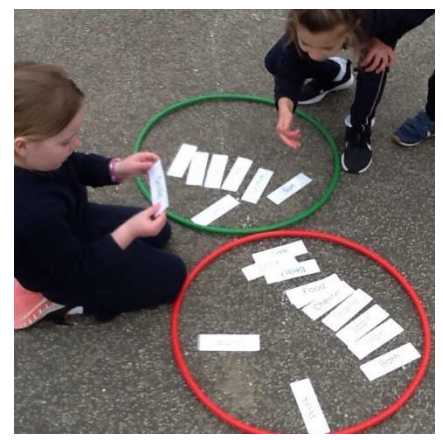
In R.E. we have answering our enquiry question 'What does the cross mean to Christians?' which has led us to the story of Easter.
