Essential Skills:

- **Recognising Set 2 sounds** and continuing to revise Set 1.
- Practise reading and spelling the new red word of the week, and previous words of the week **was**, I, the, my, me, put, of, she, he, to, go, no, you, said, be, are, all
- Reading – **5 times per week**.
- Writing numbers 11-20 (the teen numbers) and knowing the value of tens and ones in that number.

Reading books / Reading records

All books are changed on **Monday** and stamped by the classroom teacher. Start a new double page spread for the new week to record when you have heard your child read. Please do come and find me if you have any questions about the recent changes to reading at school. 😊

Maths:

This week in Maths we have been comparing numbers and their value, consolidating our use of the key vocabulary – **great, greater, more, less, fewer**. We have been using numicon, 10 frames, dice, and number lines to support our learning about identifying the number 1 more and 1 less than a given number.

We have also been representing our learning using '**maths stories**'.

See attached optional activity and see if your child can create a maths story of their own. In the activity a toy bus scenario is suggested for creating the story, but the context could easily be adapted to... number of fruits in the fruit bowl, people in the dolls house, teddies on the bed, or cars in the toy garage.

Gressenhall Wren Class Trip.

Thursday 13th June is when Wren Class will be going to visit Gressenhall Farm and Workhouse for their school trip. A lovely day is planned based around the theme of Traditional and Fairy tales. This nicely ties into lots of the stories explored in Wren Class this last term ('Jack and the Beanstalk' and the final Summer term where our key text will be 'The Princess and the Pea'.
