- Reading – **5 times per week.**
- Learning doubles for numbers 1-5. E.g. Double 1 is 2, double 2 is 4, double 3 is 6...

Family Trees



This week we have been talking about our families and noticing how each family unit is unique. We have similarities and differences between each family, but each one is very special. We read the picture book 'We are Family' as well as creating family portraits. We would like you to create a family tree that you share with your child over the half term break.

I have attached a tree outline template that you might like to download, print and use, but similarly you might like to design your own or share family photos on Tapestry.

Maths:

This week in Maths we have been exploring the concept of sharing. We started by using unifix cubes and then Numicon, to investigate which numbers we could share equally between two people and those that we cannot (numbers 1-10). We then read the story 'The Doorbell Rang' by Pat Hutchins to complete a further sharing investigation where mum bakes some cookies, and these are shared by different amounts of children as they come and go visiting the her home.

To practice the skill of sharing you might, I have attached an activity to complete with your child over the half term holiday should you wish.
