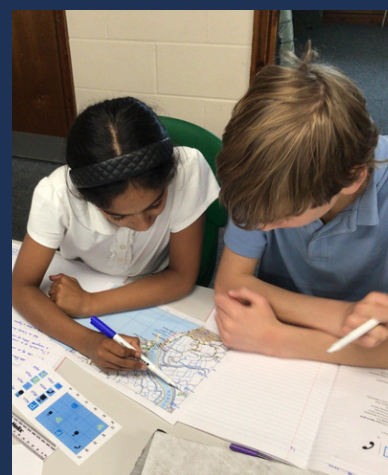


YEAR 5 SUMMER 2

CURRICULUM

Next half term, we will continue with the theme of rivers in Geography but will be shifting our focus onto learning about key rivers in the UK, Europe and South America and the impact - both positive and negative - they have had on humans.

In Maths, the children will learn how to accurately interpret statistics presented in a range of forms and will further develop their conceptual understanding of 2D/3D shapes and angles. They will also learn how to write persuasively for a range of audiences and purposes in English.

Science lessons will continue to focus on Properties and Changes of Materials; the children will work scientifically to investigate how best to keep liquids warm and present their findings in line graphs.

In PSHE, as part of our 'Changing Me' topic, we will discuss self-image; learn how boys' and girls' bodies change during puberty as well as understanding what is meant by conception.
