Essential Skills:

- **Recognising Set 2 sounds** and continuing to revise Set 1. (Reminder of set 2 sounds: ay, ee, igh, ow, oo (long vowel sound), oo (short vowel sound), ar, or, air, ir, ou, oy.
- Practise reading and spelling the new red words of the week, and previous words of the week **for**, I, the, my, me, put, of, she, he, to, go, no, you, said, be, are, all, was, some, come,
- Learning number bonds to 10. E.g. 10+0 9+1 8+2, etc.

Talk for Writing – The Princess and the Pea

This week in Maths we have been exploring different ways to show how numbers to 10 are made. We used Numicon tiles, tens frames, part whole model, cubes and bead strings to represent our findings.
