- **Recognising Set 2 sounds** and continuing to revise Set 1.
- Practise reading and spelling the new red words of the week, and previous words of the week **like**, I, the, my, me, put, of, she, he, to, go, no, you, said, be, are, all, was, some, come, for
- Learning number bonds to 10. E.g. 10+0 9+1 8+2, etc.

I have attached another number bonds to 10 activity that you might like to do at home with your child this week. Play 'The Number bonds to 10 bus game'!

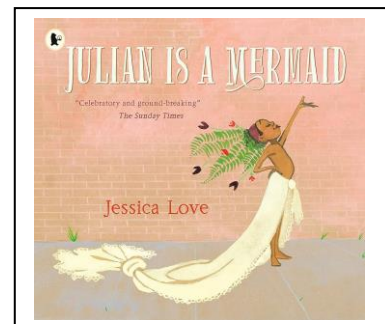
## **Next week**
