Coding Club

Dear Families,

I will be running an after-school Python Code Club every Thursday, aimed at Years 4, 5 and 6. Python is an intuitive programming language that allows us to build computer programs quickly and efficiently. During our sessions, we will create (among other things) a chatbot, a password checker, a nickname generator, and even a script that will run on the International Space Station (children will receive a certificate, showing where above the Earth the ISS was when it ran their code).
