Dear Parents/Carers,

Today your child/ren should have arrived home with four home-learning books published by CGP.

- KS2 Maths - Arithmetic SAT Buster
- KS2 Maths - Targeted Question Book
- KS2 English GPS - Targeted Question Book
- KS2 English Reading Comp - Targeted Question Book

THE WAY YEAR 6 HOME-LEARNING WORKS:

- Each week, home-learning will be set on the class page of the school website. Just click on the left side tab that says Home-Learning 2024-2025.
- Reading and spelling will be set every week with an extra spelling activity worksheet from our school scheme. Some children may be given different spellings to learn each week but these will come home in paper form.
- Pages from two or more of the books will be set each week relating to the learning that is going on in class most of the time. Not all the books will have homework pages set each week though.
- I am happy for you and your child/ren to self-mark using the answers at the back of the books but remember to be honest as learning from mistakes is important.
- There is no need to bring your books in every week to be marked.
- HOWEVER, I would still like your child/ren to ask/tell me if they have struggled with particular questions, as it is important to know in order to help them and the rest of the class.
- Now that we have new reading diaries, I would ask parents to put a comment in the reading diary to the effect of '..... has completed all their homework this week'. This helps me know who is doing homework in Y6, as it is especially good transition preparation for Y7.
- Finally, homework, although good for High School preparation, is not compulsory. If your child is unwell, or is anxious over it, then leave it and do something relaxing and mindful instead. :-)
