The top class for Reading Stars this week is: Starling Class

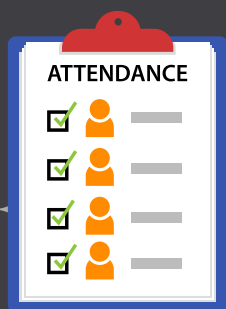


Dear Families,

As you're aware, two of our INSET days this year are on Tuesdays and not at the end or beginning of terms. We understand that this is a little more difficult to plan for. This is because we have engaged the renowned educator, writer and researcher Shirley Clarke to run learning teams with teaching staff across both Halcyon and other schools. During the training days, teachers will be learning about developing a learning culture, questioning pupils' prior knowledge, using talk partners, supporting pupils to develop targets for lessons and easing their cognitive load. One of the key impacts on teaching and learning is how teachers feed back to pupils during lessons to help them move on quickly. As part of developing a learning culture, pupils are learning to understand that their 'marvellous mistakes' help them to learn and that not knowing the answer all the time is part of learning. We are determined that valuable staff training days improve teaching and learning as much as possible. Staff use their learning to improve their practice in the classroom and then share their experiences on the final day of training. We are always looking for ways to 'Help everyone find joy in learning, feel safe to mistakes and know when they are successful' as stated in the School's vision, mission and aims.
