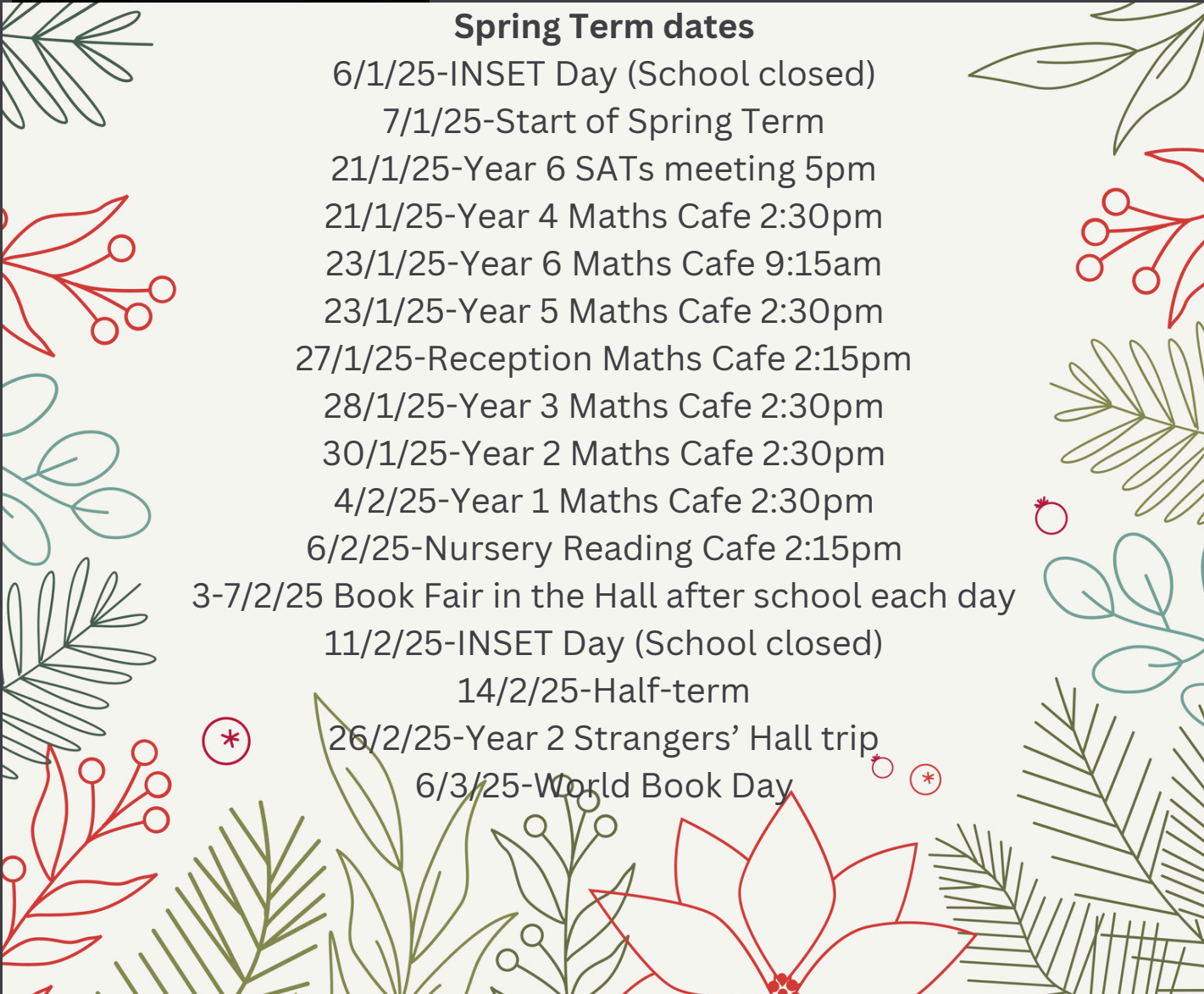
He has taken to the role brilliantly, is gaining confidence already and has been well supported by the school's headteacher.

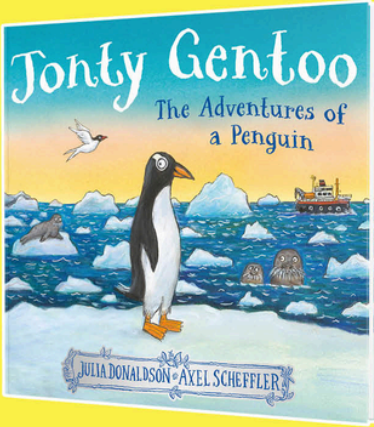
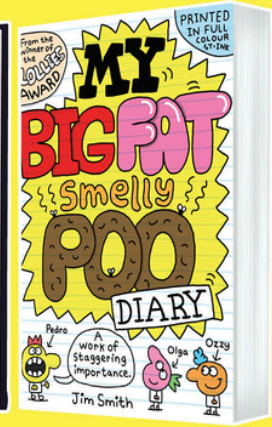
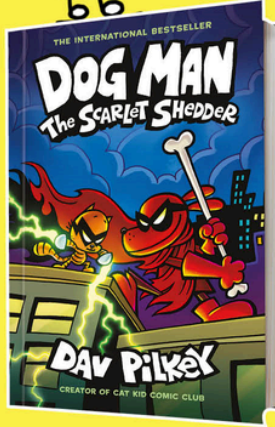
