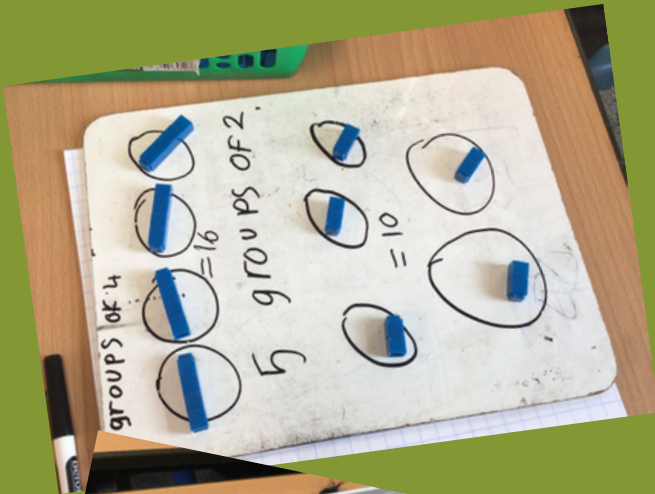




GREENFINCH CLASS SPRING 1

Spring 1 learning:

We will be starting *The Wild Robot* as our class story in Spring 1. Our focus for writing will be on writing a portal story, where our characters are whisked off to an exciting new world. We will be learning how to write an effective setting description.

In maths, we are going to look at how to calculate using multiplication and division. We will then learn about graphs and measuring length and perimeter.

The topic focus for the Spring term will shift to Geography, in the first half term we are going to be learning about Antarctica. We will discover its climate, location, what lives there as well as look at the history of exploring Antarctica.

Our science will be on the topic of Animals, Including Humans. We will be comparing different types of animal and learning about the similarities and differences between living things.

We will be learning to use and making our own branching databases in computing. Our R.E. will be a humanist exploration of morality and where it comes from. P.E. for the half term will be Football.
