



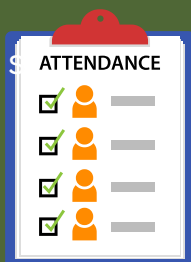

Dear Families,

- We were very excited to take delivery of the Halcyon Federation minibuses this week! We are now training and testing drivers before beginning to use the buses for sports fixtures, swimming, pupil council visits, staff development at other schools or venues and supporting on school trips. Use of the minibuses should help to reduce our carbon footprint and help to make us more sustainable.
- Thank you once again to our Friends for all of their work-from planting bulbs to fundraising!
- We ask pupils and families to read together at least 5 times per week and sign everyone's reading record. This is to give children the opportunity to gain positive experiences around reading with a loved one. Adults will also model reading and new vocabulary with children as well as contextualising and relating experiences of the world. However you share a book is helpful to children whether you read, you share, they read, you ask questions, you discuss, etc. The most important piece of homework any child can do in primary school is reading all the way up to Year 6. Confident readers use their reading skills to form better links between knowledge and skills across the curriculum, enabling them to retain more learning and adapt their understanding based on their wide-ranging knowledge of the world.

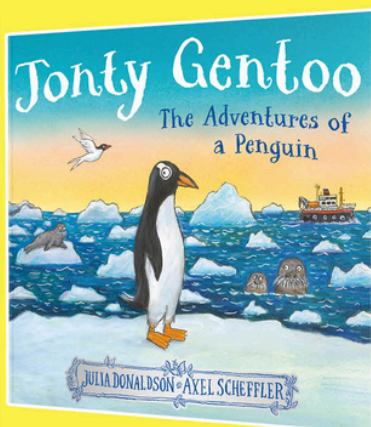
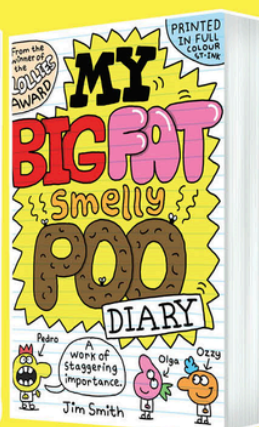
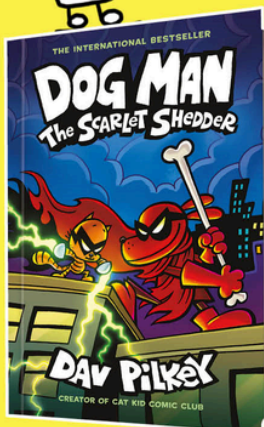
