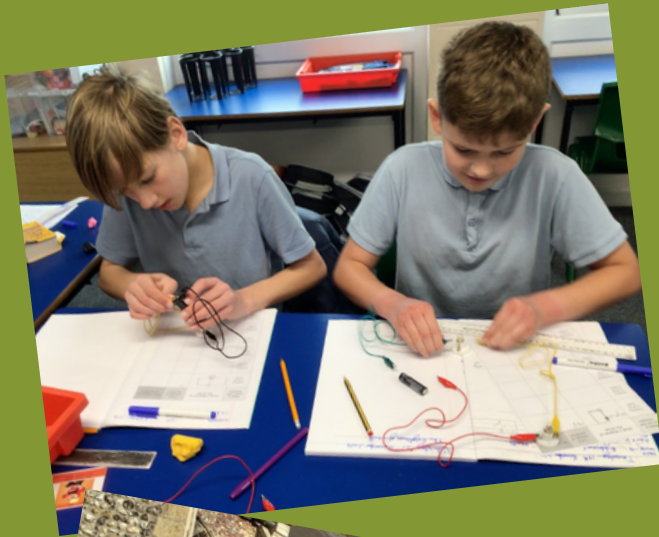




KINGFISHER CLASS SPRING 1

Spring 1 Half-Term Learning:

Maths will mostly be based around fractions, decimals and percentages. The topic of the term will be Science based - focusing on evolution and inheritance. Our DT topic will be making electrical doodlers which links nicely to the work they have learnt about electrical circuits this term. In Geography, the children will be learning about where our energy comes from. In other foundation subjects, they will be learning about clothes in French, finding what it means to be human and the purpose of life in RE and programming in computing.
