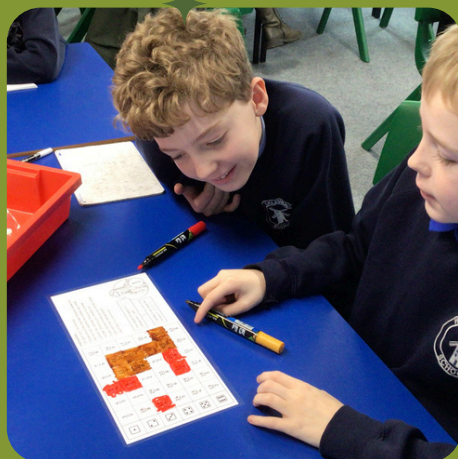

## FRIENDS

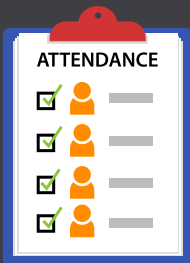
The Wicklewood Friends are busy planning fundraising and community events throughout the year so stay posted for news about a range of exciting opportunities over the rest of the term.
