## Spring 2 Curriculum

In history, we will travel even further back into the past to learn about the Great Fire of London and how it started in 1666. Our trip to Strangers' Hall in the first week of the half term will launch this topic! This will link to our Design & Technology lessons where we will be choosing strong, stable materials to construct miniature timber frame houses.

In maths, we will begin our term by working with money including recognising coins and notes and using the £ and p symbol. Our second unit will introduce multiplication and division using concrete resources. We will work on the 2, 5 and 10 times tables before playing our first notes on Times Tables Rock Stars.

Our science learning for the second half term will be centered on plants and what they need to grow. As the weather gets nicer, we will plan on spending lots of time outside exploring all the different plants that grow around our school. We will also conduct an experiment to see where we can get plants to grow in our classroom.

In PSHE, as part of the 'Healthy Me' Jigsaw theme, children will learn about all the things they can do to keep their bodies and minds healthy including exercise and healthy eating.
