## Spring 2 learning:

During the second half of the Spring term we are shifting to non-fiction writing. We will be learning how to write an engaging, fact-based information text.

In maths, we will be completing our work on length and perimeter, looking at telling the time to the nearest minute and starting our work on fractions.

We will be continuing the focus on Geography in our topic and will be looking at the rainforest, including the features of the canopy and the lives of indigenous people. We will link our topic to English by creating a fact file on the rainforest.

In science, we are going to further our work on animals including humans by looking at nutrition before an in depth study of different categories of animal. The work on nutrition is going to link to DT where we will be designing and creating a dish based on seasonal, nutritious ingredients.

R.E. will include a study of Islam including understanding what the Qur'an is and looking at how Islam differs from other religions we have studied.

In art we will be completing a mixed media project that uses shape and colour to create an effect on the viewer.
