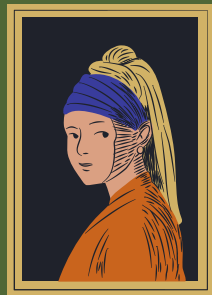
THIS WEEK

Pupils attending Forest School enjoyed their sessions with Explore4More, the group who are leading the provision this term. They led some excellent problem-solving and adventure activities which supported team-building and innovation.



Over the summer term, each year group will be holding Art Cafes and class assemblies. The Art Cafes will focus on the school Humanae project where the pupils will use the work of Angelica Dass to investigate their uniqueness and self-image as well as the diversity of humanity. Families are welcome to attend and support.
