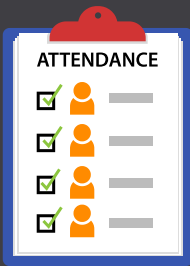
Miss Ding, Mrs Knights and Miss Samuel will continue to be key members of the team supporting the pupils in Year 1.
