In science this term, we will investigate different habitats and learn about food chains. This will be supported by a trip to How Hill for pond dipping, where we will have the chance to observe creatures in their natural environment.

In Design and Technology, we'll use everything we've explored so far about nutrition and healthy choices by making our own delicious and nutritious wraps!
