## First Half-Term Learning:

In English, we will be reading *The Explorer* by Katherine Rundall. Our writing will be focused on suspense, especially on “showing not telling”.

Our term long Geography theme on rivers begins this half-term by looking at the water cycle, how rivers are formed and local rivers.
