Summer 1:

Our writing focus for this half term will be on persuasive texts. We will be working on a model text convincing people to visit ancient Colchester. We will be learning to use language to convince other people.

Maths this half term will be all about angles and shapes. We will be investigating and identifying different types of angle. We will be classifying 2d and 3d shapes as well as calculating perimeters.

In history we will be learning about the Roman invasion of Britain. We will be finding out why the Romans invaded and the impact that it had on Britain.

Our science work on plants will conclude by learning about plant reproduction and seed dispersal.

In DT we will be completing a project linked to our history work. We will investigate the features of Roman castles and fortifications before designing and building our own.

Computing will include some work on desktop publishing, we will be using Word and Powerpoint and learning how to edit text for different effects. We will also be finding out how to add and animate the appearance of images.
