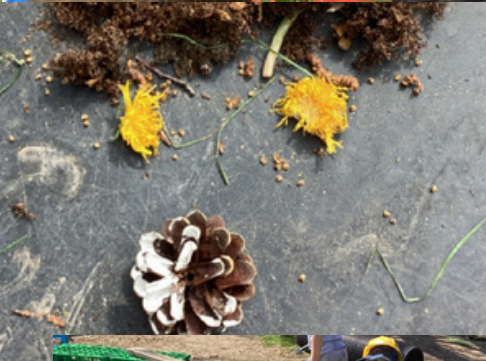




# WAGTAIL CLASS SUMMER 2

The Wagtail Class children have had a wonderful first half term of the Summer. We have been amazed by the children's imagination relating to our key text 'Three Billy Goats Gruff'. Through Talk for Writing they have created their own stories and have been trip trapping across bridges made in the garden. During our Jigsaw time we have been talking about being a good friend and drawing pictures of our friends, this has been linked to zones of regulation. We have also found out about bees during World Bee Day and celebrated our differences through our Humanae art work.



## Summer 2 Term Learning:

Our class focus text for the second half of the Summer term is 'The Rainbow Fish' by Marcus Pfister, which we are excited to explore through all areas of our curriculum.

Through communication and language we will explore new vocabulary naming parts of a fish. We will consider 'why' questions when thinking about Rainbow Fish's actions in the story. Through Talk for Writing we will use actions to accompany the story following a story map.

Within our physical development the children will recreate movements based on characters in the story. We will explore drawing, painting and printing sea creatures.

Mathematical development will provide opportunities to count, order and recognise numbers to five. We will also be comparing quantities using the appropriate mathematical language.

During our PSHE we will be discussing moving on to school and how we grow and change. The children will learn to name parts of their bodies and to show respect for ourselves. We will learn about sharing, following the character's feelings in The Rainbow Fish.
