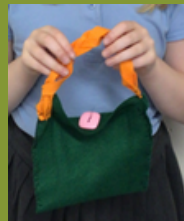
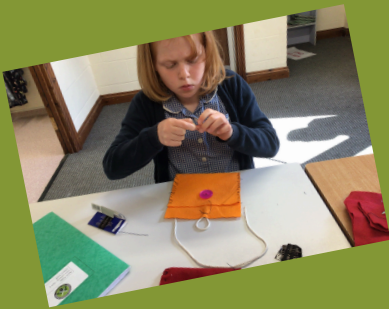




LAPWING CLASS SUMMER 2
