This newsletter will tell you more about the learning we have coming up over this half term, and any important dates you need to know about!

Autumn Term 1

In English this half term, our model text is The Enormous Turnip! We will be learning to retell this story using actions, and innovating by changing the characters, places and objects to make it our own. At the end of the half term we will be learning how to write our own cumulative story.

To begin with this half term, we will be focusing on numbers within 10, looking at how we can represent numbers and investigate their composition.

In our Science lessons, we will be exploring seasonal changes, observing the changes across the four seasons, and describing weather associated with the seasons.

In Geography we will be looking at the concept question 'What is it like here?', and exploring the technology around us with a focus on Computer Systems and Networks in our Computing lessons. We will be focusing on fundamental skills in PE sessions, and 'Being Me In My World' in PSHE. In R.E. we will be exploring what our senses tell us about the world of religion and belief. D&T will focus on cooking and nutrition, where Jay class will be making soup!
