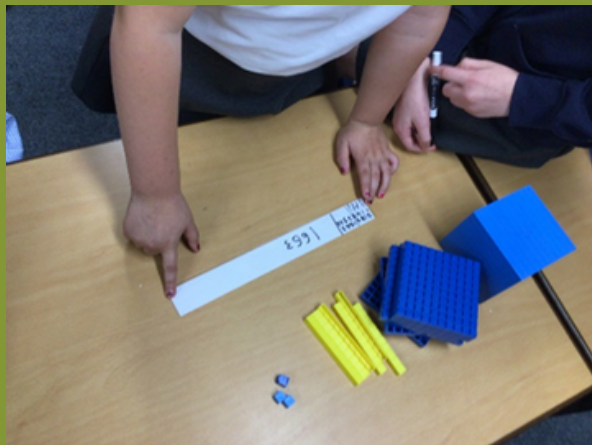
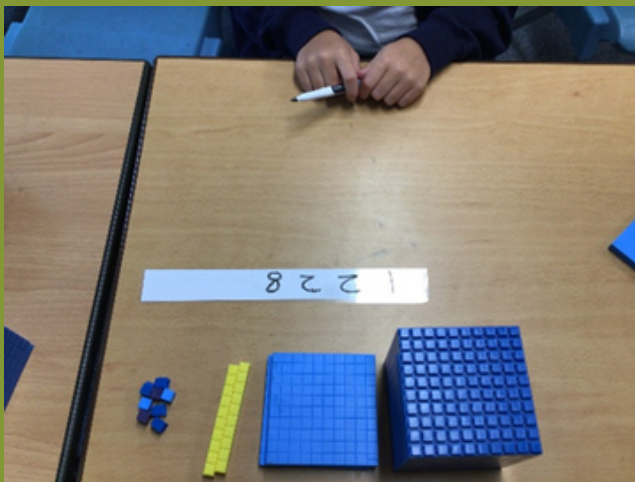




# LAPWING CLASS AUTUMN 1
