Autumn 2 Curriculum

In English, we'll be putting our historian hats on as we write our very own news reports about the Blitz. Using everything we've learned in our history lessons - from how people experienced air raids to the impact on daily life - pupils will take on the role of wartime reporters to inform their readers about the dramatic events of the Blitz. This will be a fantastic opportunity to combine historical knowledge with journalistic writing skills, creating engaging and informative reports that bring the past to life.

In Science, our focus will be on Electricity. Pupils will explore voltage and power in circuits, learning how these affect the flow of electricity. We'll also be identifying different circuit components, understanding their functions, and using symbols and diagrams to represent circuits accurately.

In History, we will be studying the census to understand life in the past, including Victorian working conditions and changes over time. Pupils will use the census and other sources to make inferences, ask questions, and find out information about their local area.

In Art, we will be exploring 2D perspective drawing, inspired by the work of Henry Moore. Pupils will learn how to create depth and dimension in their drawings, experimenting with shapes, lines, and shading to capture the essence of Moore's style.
