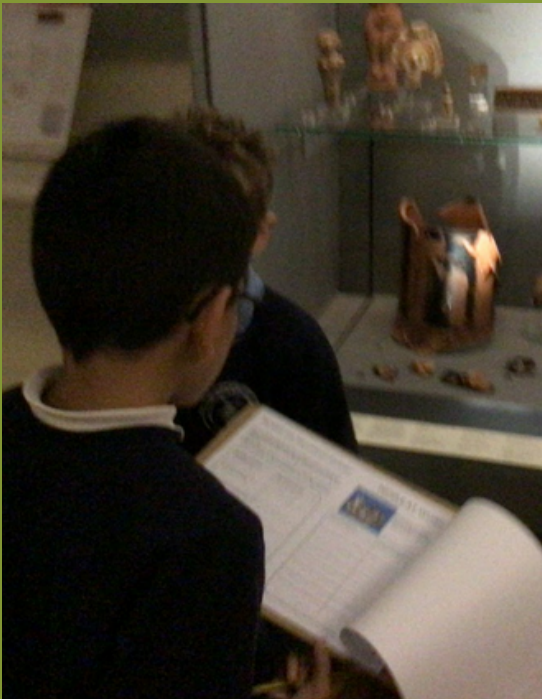
Second Half-Term Learning:
