We will continue our exploration of the ancient Maya in history, focusing especially on their beliefs and rich artistic traditions - including the glyphs, carvings, sculptures and codices that recorded their stories.

In maths, we will strengthen our work with fractions, including adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing them. We will also connect percentages to fractions and decimals.

We are looking forward for our trip to Norwich Cathedral, where the children will investigate how different materials affect echoes, acoustics and vibrations around the space. The cathedral's stained glass windows will also guide our art unit as we think about using patterns and motifs to convey information and share stories.
