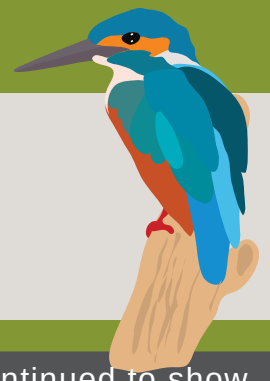


KINGFISHER CLASS SPRING TWO

Spring Two Curriculum

This half term, our learning continues to build thoughtfully across the curriculum. In Maths, we will begin exploring Geometry, applying our reasoning skills to new concepts while still dedicating regular time to revisiting key arithmetic areas such as multiplication, division, and fractions, decimals and percentages to keep skills sharp as we approach SATs.

Our Writing lessons will centre around biographical writing, with the children studying the life and work of Charles Darwin, linking closely to our Science topic on evolution. This cross-curricular approach will allow pupils to deepen both their subject knowledge and their writing skills.

In Geography, we will examine population and consider how and why it changes over time, while in RE we will explore the thought-provoking question of whether science and religion are complementary or conflicting – a unit that is sure to spark engaging, respectful debate and thoughtful discussion.
