Spring Term Learning:

During 'Talk for Writing' we will retell the story, using story maps and explore creating our own versions of the story.

Mathematical development will provide opportunities to explore positional language, patterns, counting seeds, flowers, beans and comparing different quantities.

Our PSHE sessions we will be discussing how to be healthy, basic hygiene and safety. We will also look at how we have grown and things we can do which we couldn't do as babies.

Within Expressive Arts and Design, the children will be doing observational drawing of our sprouting seeds and using natural materials in clay to create models.
