



## Wren Class Home Learning

### Essential Skills:

- Letter and number formation - correct formation of letters a-z and numbers 0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10
- Practise reading and spelling the two new red words of the week, and previous words of the week -go, no, I, the, my, me, put, of, she, he, to
- Reading 5 times a week as a minimum.
- We have learned about 'Red Zone' feelings. Ask your child and talk about times that they have felt ... angry or terrified. Then ask the children what they could do to support these feelings and move to a calmer state. Some of the tools we have learned about are:

Finger breathing

Scrunching up paper

Spider crawling

Watching sand or glitter pass through a jar/timer

Going for a walk

Talking with another adult

Take your pencil for a walk.

Practise reading and spelling the red words

I, the, my, me, put, of, she, he, to, go, no

### Maths:

I have attached an Easter themed maths activity booklet. This consolidates all the work we have been doing in maths this term. This is optional.

### Phonics

As your child will not be taking part in any phonics sessions for over two weeks it would be fantastic if they could have a look at the sounds they have learnt to date, at least a couple of times over the holiday. This will help to ensure they remember them on our return to school. For some children this will be Set 1 sounds, for other children this will be Set 2.

### Literacy

I have attached a 'my Easter' sheet. It would be lovely if the children could draw a picture of something they do over the Easter holidays and write a short sentence underneath. In school we encourage children to sound out words themselves. At this stage, it is more important for the children to attempt to sound out words and write independently, rather than spell all words correctly. If your child would like to bring in their work when we return after the Easter break, they will have an opportunity to share them with their friends. This is optional.
