Summer Term Learning:

Through communication and language we will use small world resources to role play the story. During Talk for Writing we will use actions to accompany the story following a story map. We will then use our imagination to innovate our story.

Within our physical development the children will work together to make bridges to cross using the large scale construction resources and stepping stones. We will use tools to create our own Monet class display linking to rivers and ponds.

Mathematical development will provide opportunities to learn the names of 2-D and 3-D shapes and we will also compare quantities using words such as greater, less, more, fewer.

During our PSHE sessions we will be discussing relationships through our families and friends. We will look at showing respect to each other and how to be a good friend.
