### Summer 1:

Our focus for writing will be to write a persuasive text about visiting Colchester Castle. We will be using a combination of descriptive and persuasive techniques.

Maths will start with looking at angle and shape. We will be exploring acute, obtuse and reflex angles. We will also be looking at parallel and perpendicular lines as well as the properties of 2D and 3D shape.

In Science we are learning about plants. We will be exploring how plants reproduce by investigating the parts of a flower and the processes of pollination and seed dispersal.

History will be about answering the question of why the Romans invaded Britain. We will look at what the Romans wanted, how Britain responded and why they were successful. We will also find out why Roman invasion was so impactful.

For the Summer term, RE will require us to consider why people have different beliefs about God. We will revisit our learning about different faiths before thinking about what we believe.

DT will be linked to our learning about the Romans. We will be looking at how fortifications have changed in Britain and investigating how castles were used for defence before creating our own model castles.
