Essential Skills:

- **Recognising Set 2 sounds** and continuing to revise Set 1.
- Practise reading and spelling the new red word of the week, and previous words of the week **be, are, I, the, my, me, put, of, she, he, to, go, no, you, said**
- Reading - **5 times per week.**
- Writing numbers 11-20 (the teen numbers) and knowing the value of tens and ones in that number.

Reading books / Reading records

Your child will have come home with their new reading record book this week, alongside their Read, Write, Inc phonics book pack and an additional reading book from the scheme Big Cat Collins.

Please hear your child read any combination of this choice of books at least 5 times a week and indicate each time you have heard your child read by writing the name of the book you heard your child read, inserting a comment and saying who read with your child.

Please note, some of the words in the Big Cat Collins books may be too tricky for your child to decode. These books should be used as a share read with your child and focus much more on

exposing new vocabulary to the children, different text types (stories, information texts, plays), learning more words by sight, and comprehension. Do not expect your child to be able to read these books independently. Our Read, Write, Inc books focus on practicing and extending phonetic knowledge.

On Monday's reading record books will be checked by the teacher. A gold merit star is awarded for all those that have read 5 times.

Don't forget, reading record books and all reading books should be sent into school every day in their book bags. Thank you!

Maths:

We have continued our work on numbers 11 - 20 this week. This week we played a game of 'I'm thinking of a number ...'. I would say how many tens and ones in a number and the children had to write and say which number I was thinking of. I was amazed at how many children could tell me the numbers of tens and ones in a number up to 20. It was clear lots of people had been practising at home, so thank you for your support.

I have added a number to 20 maths mat if anyone wants to practise further at home.
