Spellings

Maths

We are having a focus and push of learning our first times tables. Please support your child in learning their 2 and 5 times tables. Counting forward and backwards in 2s and 5s. If they have grasped their tables the next stage is looking at division. Such as 10 divided by 2 = ? or 25 divided by 5 =?

English

We are continuing to develop our descriptive skills in English, looking in class at how we can describe a woodland setting. We will next be looking at character. Can you describe a mythical creature, maybe a dragon or a unicorn? Challenge yourself to use great adjectives, alliteration and can you add a simile. Remember your words are painting the picture for the reader.

Reading records

Thank you for helping your child record their reading sessions so far this term! Our goal is to have everyone in Swift reading at least 5 times each week.

A few reminders:

- Please help children remember to bring their reading records in to school every day.

- Please make sure that even if the child records their reading session for the day that an adult signs or initials the box to acknowledge that they have read.
- Books are collected and changed on Mondays, if children have finished their book on another day we will do our best to change. It is fine if they are reading the Collins Big Cat books more than once, it is all invaluable practise for comprehension and fluency
