Maths:

This week in Maths we have been exploring the properties of 2D (flat) shapes.

We have been exploring what shapes we can use to make new shapes. For example, we cut a square in half to make 2 right-angled triangles. We then used the triangles to make new shapes - a large triangle and a parallelogram. We then explored using small square shapes to make long, wide rectangles and larger squares. The children have especially enjoyed using the shape provision in class to make quilts for the 'Princess' in our class story, 'The Princess and the Pea.'
