Essential Skills:

- Reading – 5 times per week. Please focus on using the picture and context of a book to read unfamiliar words. Remember our phonics is only one way in which we can read words. The pictures, context and knowing words by sight are all crucial in helping us to be readers.
- **Recognising Set 2 sounds** and continuing to revise Set 1.
- Practise reading and spelling the new red words of the week (**people**), and previous words of the week I, the, my, me, put, of, she, he, to, go, no, you, said, be, are, all, was, some, come, for, like
- Sharing and grouping numbers

Maths:

This week in Maths we have been learning about how to share a set of objects equally. We shared objects between 2 and then went on to discover if objects could be shared equally between 3 or even 4.

Some children discovered that when sharing a number of objects between 2 people it was only the even numbers that could be shared equally and not the odd. We talked about cutting somethings in half to share equally. E.g. If you had 3 cookies that were shared between 2 people. Each person could have 1 and half cookies.

I have attached an activity that you might like to have a go at doing with your child based around teddies having a picnic.
