This week in maths we have been learning to describe turns using full turn, half turn, quarter turn and three quarter turn. There is a worksheet below for children to complete.

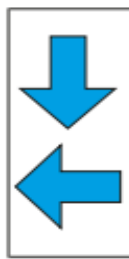
## Messages-

quarter turn

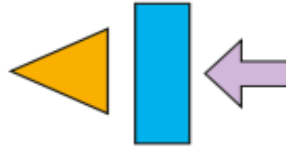


half turn
