### Maths

This week, we have understanding percentages and finding percentages of amounts using the bar method and the knowledge below.

- To find 50% of a number, divide it by 2.
- To find 10% of a number, divide it by 10.
- To find 1% of a number, divide it by 100.

From these, we have been able to find 25%, 5%, 2% and multiples of 10%.
