THE KEY STAGE ONE REVAMP

The amazing fundraising last year enabled the Friends to support school initiatives that went beyond our regular coach, bookbag, year book commitments. The Friends donated £3,664 to help towards a revamp of KS1 inside and outside areas.

"Friends Funding helped make the classrooms more inviting and well organised with new shelving for all the Early Years and KS1 classes, enabling the children to have easier access to the equipment and resources they need, increasing their independence and ownership of their learning. The KS1 outside areas, between reception and Year One and behind Year Two have also received Friends funding for resources like tuff spots, water trays, mud kitchen, building equipment and outside storage for resources, transforming these areas into outside learning spaces".
