**YEAR 5 (KESTREL) TRIP TO SAINSBURY CENTRE, NORWICH  
THURSDAY 25<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY 2024**

Dear Parents/Carers,

I am excited to inform you that we have been offered a wonderful opportunity to work exclusively with a **professional artist** at **The Sainsbury Centre, in Norwich, on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> January** as part of our studies of the Ancient Mayan Civilisation.

In the workshop, pupils will look closely at relief carvings from the period especially Mayan jade pendants, engraved shell discs, and a greenstone Hacha, as well as Ulúa marble vessels.

They will look at the Mayan codex, and the patterns and glyphs which can be seen carved into the surface of the objects in the gallery, and what these could represent.

The students will explore different ways of creating an image by taking away material, and will have the opportunity to try creating reliefs in polystyrene and carving with wax.

The visit will also allow time to look at the gallery's extensive main collection.

**Details**

The children will travel by coach. We will depart at approximately 9.15am and will return before the end of the school day.

Please ensure your child has a packed lunch in a bag and a refillable water bottle on this day. They should also wear normal school uniform and sensible footwear. A suitable

coat or waterproof will also be needed as there will be a short walk from the coach drop off point.
