## Spelling

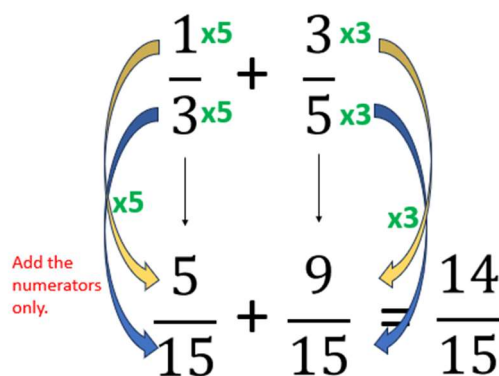
