# BAG 2 SCHOOL

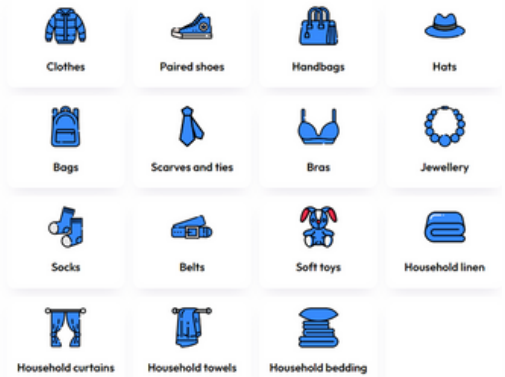
A message from the School's Eco-Council:
