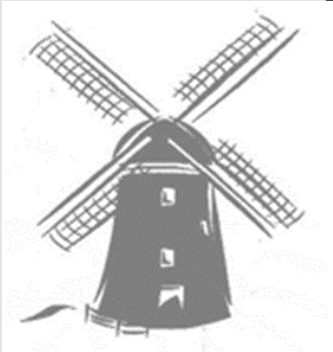

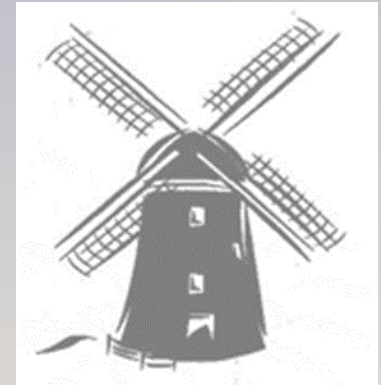


The Rule of Law

- **A value is a principle that guides our thinking and behaviour.**





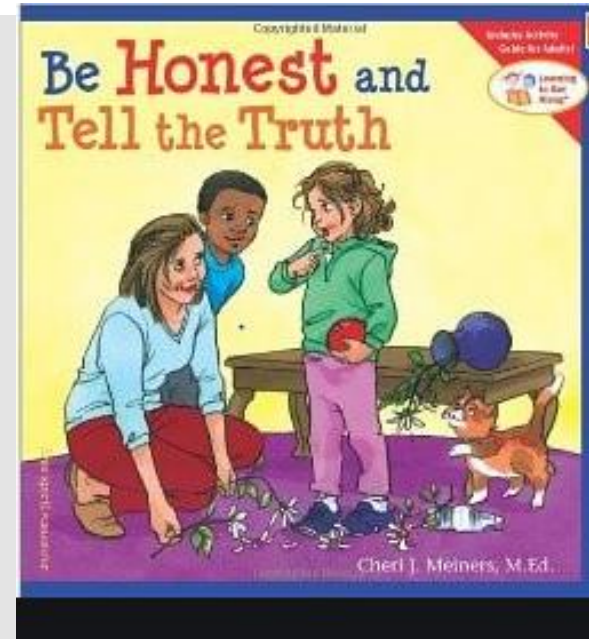

- Explaining what really happened

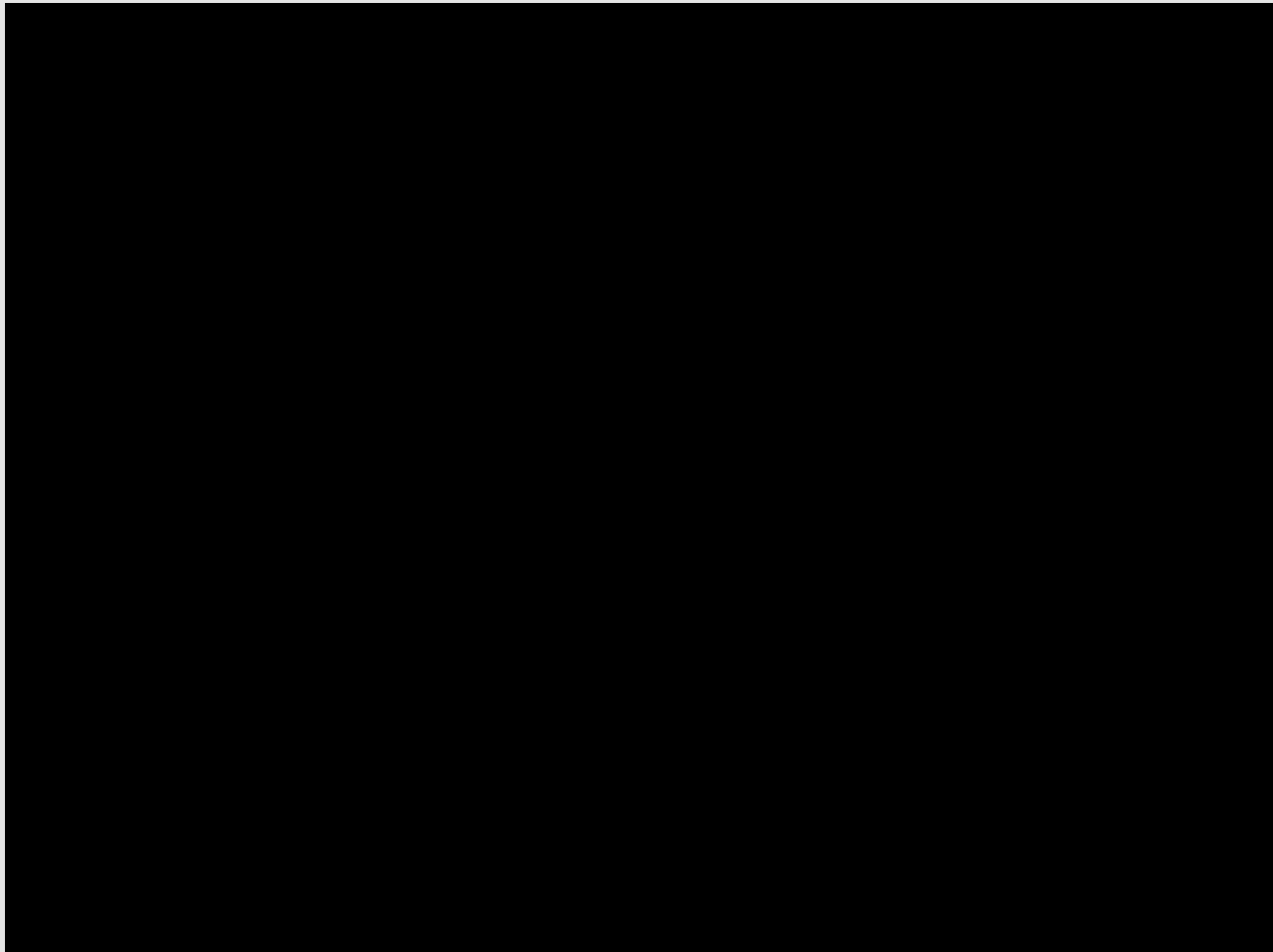


Honesty is not:

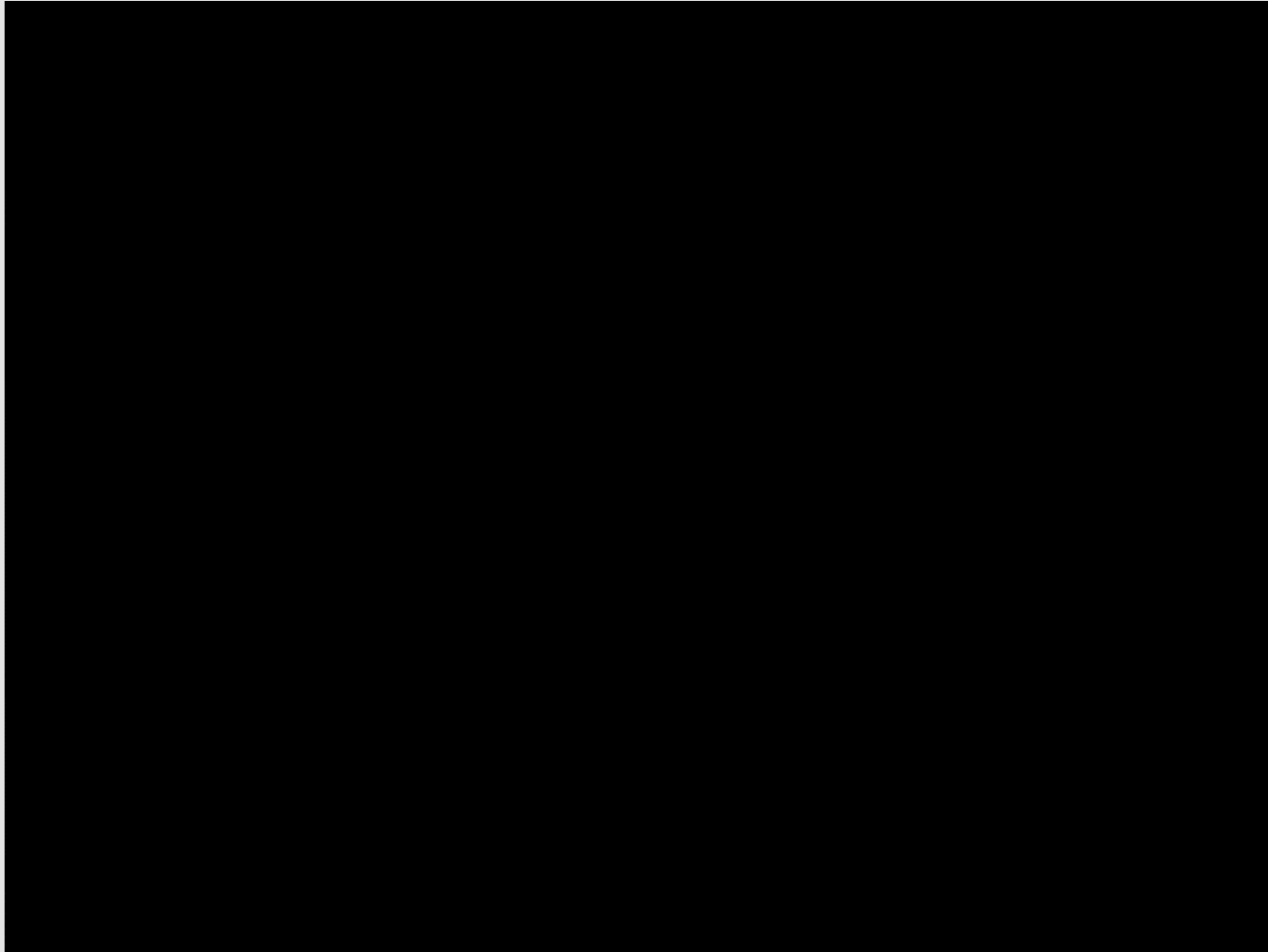

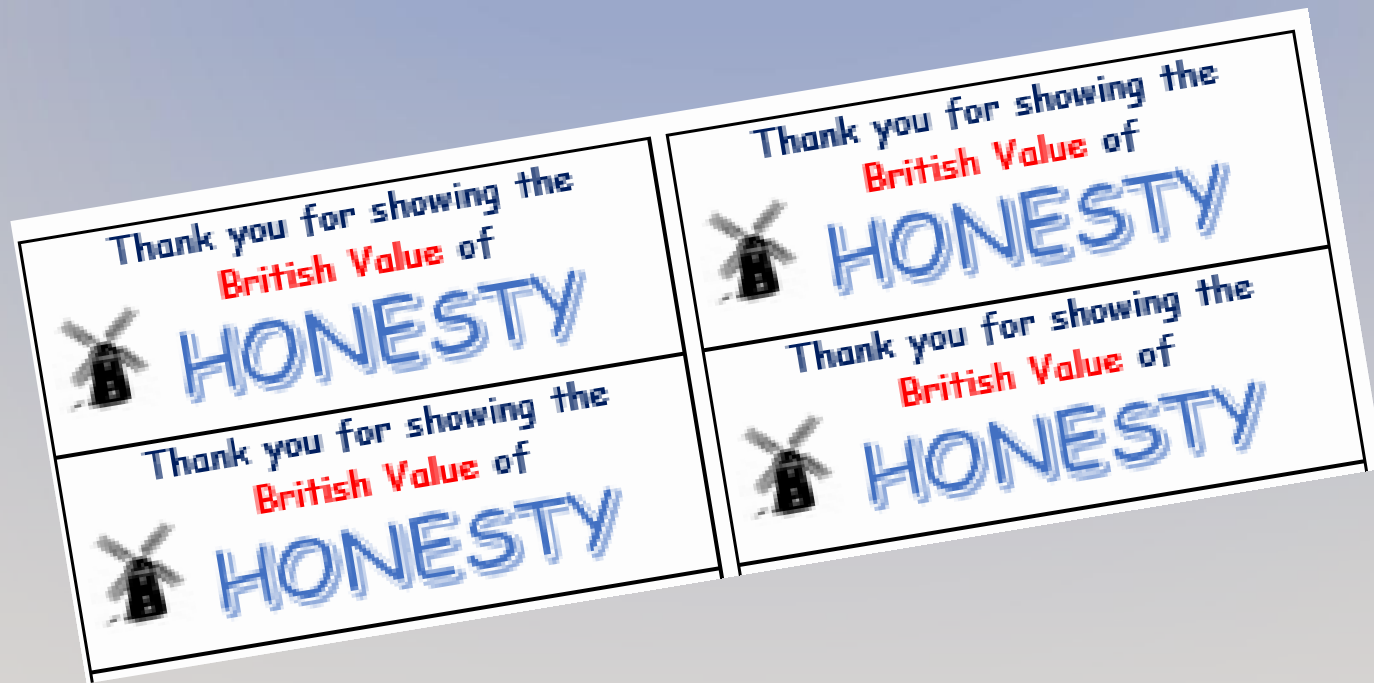
